

NURSERY INFORMATION

We want your child to see the love of Christ through the care they receive when they are with us. It is our desire to provide a safe, loving, clean, and creative environment.



- ⇒ The Nursery is for newborns through children completing 5 year old kindergarten.
- ⇒ Nurseries open 15 minutes prior to services and other scheduled events.
- ⇒ Please label your child's belongings, diaper bags, & bottles.
- ⇒ Please bring only disposable diapers.
- ⇒ Please do not bring personal toys to the nursery unless it is your child's favorite "security" toy.

HOW PARENTS CAN HELP

- ◆ Please put your cell phone on vibrate and leave cell phone number with nursery staff for emergency.
- ◆ Parents must be on church grounds if they leave their children in the nursery.
- ◆ To help your child adjust, please bring them on a regular basis.
- ◆ Sign-in and give complete information on where you will be in the church (room number or event attending) in the event we need to find you. (PLEASE LEAVE CELL PHONE NUMBER WITH THE STAFF.)
- ◆ Please label all of your child's belongings clearly. Masking tape and markers will be provided if needed.
- ◆ Always bring a change of clothes and diapers in case of spills and soils.
- ◆ Please make sure any allergies, special instructions and limitations are noted on the sign-in sheet.
- ◆ Offer assistance when you leave your child if it looks particularly busy that day.
- ◆ Be a nursery volunteer!

SICKNESS POLICIES

- ◆ For the protection of your child and other children please do not bring a child who appears to be ill. A child should not be placed in the nursery with:
 - fever (within previous 24 hrs.)
 - vomiting or diarrhea
 - persistent green/yellow nasal discharge
 - any symptom of communicable disease (i.e. measles, mumps, chicken pox, or lice)
 - sore throat
 - rash
 - skin infection
 - pink eye or other eye infection
- ◆ We cannot administer medications.
- ◆ If a child develops a fever while in the nursery, parents will be contacted to pick the child up.
- ◆ If your child develops symptoms of an infectious and /or a contagious disease (i.e. conjunctivitis or chicken pox) after being in the nursery, please contact the church office (722-8882) so other parents can be notified of their child's exposure.

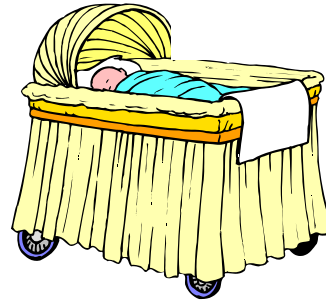


Please respect our nursery workers' and volunteers' time by picking up children promptly at the close of worship services, committee meetings, Bible studies, or other special events.
